## Dear parent

School starts back for <u>all</u> pupils on Monday, 22<sup>nd</sup> March and we are looking forward to seeing everyone again.

We will be utilising the measures we had in place before the Christmas break and would like to remind you of these.

#### <u>P1 – P7 pupils</u>

- 1. School doors will be open for a period from 8.45 a.m. to 9.05 a.m., during which pupils can walk straight to class.
- 2. This means children can be left off at any time from 8.45 a.m. to 9.05 a.m.
- 3. Children will not line up but will go straight through the door that they normally enter and will go straight to class. There will be members of staff in the playground ensuring pupils go through the right door and get to their class.
